

## **Salt Dough**

300g flour

200ml water

300g salt

2 teaspoons oil

Mix ingredients together in a bowl until it forms a dough, you may need to use your hands to bring it together. If it is a bit sticky, just add a little more flour. It is also a good idea to have a little extra flour to sprinkle on the work surface and rolling pin, if you use one. You can also dip the cutters in flour before using them to stop the dough sticking to them.

Either bake at a low temperature in the oven for up to 3 hours, (but keep checking them), or you can try microwaving them, but just do it for short bursts, until they are hard. Depending on the size and shape, it may take up to 3 minutes. If they are still soggy after this, try putting them back in for 10 seconds at a time.

To decorate, use acrylic paint or add 1 part PVA glue to 2 parts ordinary poster paint. You can add glitter to the paint to make a sparkly effect, if wanted.
